Peace & Security in the South Caucasus Program

Peace & Security explores political and cultural identity, development strategies, and ongoing efforts to overcome age-old divisions throughout this important region.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Students attend 5 hours of class per day exploring the history, geopolitics, national identity, religion, and society of the region. Students also receive language instruction at the appropriate level. Classes are conducted in English by expert faculty of Ilia State University and yield 8 to 10 U.S. academic credit hours through Bryn Mawr College.

SUPPORT SERVICES

American Councils conducts pre-departure and on-site orientations. Full-time, in-country staff oversee the program,

assist participants in academic and personal matters, and provide 24-hour emergency aid. Participants are enrolled in comprehensive overseas health, accident, and evacuation insurance for the duration of their program.

- ❑ **PROGRAM FOCUS:** Politics, conflict, and security in the South Caucasus; regional culture and identity; Russian, Georgian, Chechen or Azeri language (at all levels)
- ❑ **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to undergraduate and graduate students (must be 18 to apply)
- ❑ **LOCATION & PROGRAM TERM:** Tbilisi, Georgia; Summer (5 weeks)
- ❑ **HOUSING & MEALS:** Homestays; 2 meals per day
